

## \*The ANS/RLS key can be used to answer a ringing call or hang up.

Making Calls	Internal External	Dial the extension, station or group number. Press an idle line key or dial '9', then dial the telephone number.
Using the Speakerphone.		Press an idle line key or dial '9', then dial the telephone number to disconnect from a hands free call, press ANS/RLS To allow group listening press scroll key three times, press listen soft key.
Hold	Regular Exclusive	Press the <i>HOLD</i> key <u>once.</u> Press the <i>HOLD</i> key <u>twice</u>
		This feature will hold a line exclusively on your set and cannot be picked up from another telephone.
Transfer to another extension		While talking to the caller, press <b>DSS/BLF</b> station key or, press the <i>TRANSFER</i> key then dial extension announce the call if required, hang-up or press <b>ANS/RLS</b> key to complete the transfer
		*if you need to return to the caller press the <b>RETURN</b> soft key.
Conference Call		Make or receive your first call, press <i>CONF</i> key or press <i>SCROLL</i> . <i>CONF.</i> press <i>DSS/BLF</i> key or, dial extension or outside telephone number, press <i>CONF</i> key to add another party or press <i>CONF</i> key twice to begin conference. Maximum of 5 parties can be connected.
Personal Speed Dial		Press <b>TRANSFER</b> , dial 105 Enter speed dial memory number (00-49) Dial '9' and the telephone number Press <b>TRANSFER</b> to store the number.
To use personal Speed dial		Press <b>SPEAKER</b> or lift handset,
System wide Speed Dial		Press speed dial or dial <b>16</b> , Enter <b>2 digit</b> memory code <b>00-49</b> Press speed dial,or dial <b>16</b> Enter <b>3 digit</b> memory code <b>500-999</b>
Last Number Redial		Press <b>REDIAL</b> or dial <b>'19''</b>
Automatic Redial		Receive busy tone, press <b>SCROLL</b> and press <b>RETRY.</b> The system makes up to 15 attempts to dial the busy telephone number. Lift and replace handset to cancel.
Headset Operation		Press the <b>HEADSET</b> key to disable the handset then use the <b>Speaker</b> key to answer and disconnect callers

Paging	Lift handset and press <b>Page</b> key or dial ' <b>55</b> ' <b>+ paging group</b> . Press * for all call Page, press ANS/RLS or Press the Hook Switch
Meet Me Paging	Lift handset, dial ' <b>54' plus page group</b> Press * for all call Page, press <i>WAIT</i> softkey or <i>Transfer</i> when done. Remain off hook
To respond	On any telephone, Lift handset, Dial 56.
Changing your name	Press <b>TRANSFER</b> , dial <b>104</b> Spell your name using the keypad. press Use the <b>Volume Keys</b> to move cursor. Press <b>Hold</b> to erase name Press <b>TRANSFER</b> when complete
Changing intercom mode	Press <b>TRANSFER</b> , dial <b>103</b> Use volume keys to set intercom answer mode Press <b>TRANSFER</b> when complete

Changing Ringing	Press <b>TRANSFER</b> , dial <b>111</b> Dial <b>1</b> thru <b>8</b> or <b>Volume Keys</b> Use Volume Keys to select Yes/No Press <b>TRANSFER</b> when complete
Calling line Name/Number	Press <b>Transfer</b> dial <b>119</b> select
